



Red Flags for an urgent evacuation:

- New, abrupt, and severe pain. Patient is older than 60 years old.

Evacuation Level:

- Begin a Level 1 Evacuation.

Field Treatment:

- No exertion/exercise.

Explanation:

A sudden and severe tearing pain indicates an aortic dissection, more common in a men 50-80 years old. Death is possible.
