



Asa has a mild concussion, at least one fractured rib on his left side, an unstable left wrist (he can't use it), internal bleeding (likely from his spleen), and a potential spine injury at C-7. Both volume shock and respiratory distress are current problems due to his high pulse and respiratory rates from chest trauma. Call for assistance and for a level 1 evacuation in a commercial litter. It's very important to keep him warm as hypothermia interferes with the clotting cascade; consider a hypothermia package. Avoid exercise as this will increase his blood pressure and internal bleeding. Due to his fractured ribs, it may be difficult to keep him comfortable; if his AVPU drops, consider packaging him on his injured side with a lot of padding.
