



Grab your first aid kit and put your masks on before going ashore. Given the amount of elapsed time, the man receiving CPR is likely dead. Put your gloves on, ask the man providing CPR to stop; then, check his friend's pulse. If you cannot find a pulse, gently talk with his provider and, while reassuring him that he has done all that he could for his friend, let him know his friend is dead.

Contact the local sheriff's office, report the event, and request assistance. In addition to investigating the death, the older woman in the second raft—the dead man's wife as it turns out—is a drowning victim and should be evacuated to a hospital as quickly as possible.
