



Tiana has a severe concussion, at least one fractured rib, and she may have fractured a vertebrae; the pain in her ribs was initially controlled by her sympathetic ASR. Her high pulse and respiratory rates may be due to the pain or compensated volume shock. If you are strong enough, consider improvising a backpack carry and evacuate her; pad her ribs as best as possible; take care that you don't fall and impact her head or neck. Alternately, you may need to leave her and seek assistance. If possible, avoid a self-evacuation as it may increase any internal bleeding.
