



James appears to have a mild concussion: he has a headache (3) and a scalp hematoma. Since you were able to palpate his skull through the swelling and it felt solid, he does not have a depressed skull fracture.

Since James is under 16, begin a Level 3 evacuation to the nearest hospital for potential imaging and physician follow-up in the morning. Monitor for S/Sx of a worsening (severe) concussion and vomiting (increased ICP) through the night.
