



Your patient is mildly hypothermic, concussed, dehydrated, and has an unstable right ankle and minor head laceration. He may also have a unstable spine injury (you can't rule it out because of his sore back and neck) and a subdural hematoma (his headache is slowly getting worse; although that may be due to dehydration and not a head injury). Keep him spine stable in the hypothermia package and evacuate him in a litter to the hospital for definitive evaluation and treatment. If possible, add heat packs to his hypothermia package. Continue to give him food and water throughout the evacuation.
