



There are no red flags for an urgent evacuation. This might be Jane's normal menstrual period. If so, she should feel better in a day or two with rest and ibuprofen. That said, her reported difficulty urinating this morning with her bowel movement could indicate a an ovarian cyst. 95% of ovarian cysts function as a normal part of a women's menstrual cycle, only a few are actually dangerous. Plan for and consider beginning a level 3 evacuation if her pain/pressure continues beyond the next few days. Also plan for a level 2 evacuation in the unlikely event her pain abruptly increases (indicating a rupture) and does not resolve after 45 minutes.
