



Amnesia accompanied by a throbbing headache (6) means Jane has a severe concussion, an injured upper chest that appears to be stable, and a potential spine injury (she is not completely reliable). With no overnight equipment or cell coverage, your options are limited. Permit Jane to attempt a self-evacuation by slowly traversing down the mountain and skiing out. Check your cell coverage regularly. If Jane is unable to control her skis, you will need to make an emergency shelter and send one person out for help. If this occurs, it will be a difficult night; one that Jane may not survive.
