



Jessie has:

- 1 A skull fracture and late increased ICP: she is unresponsive with blood and likely CSF leaking from her nose and ears.
- 2 A possible spine injury.
- 3 Late volume shock, likely from damage to her liver; she is unresponsive with high pulse and respiratory rates.
- 4 Respiratory distress: she has a high, irregular respiratory rate.

Begin a Level 1 evacuation to the nearest Level 1 trauma center. Contact the sheriff's office and try to arrange a helicopter transportation over the mountains to Seattle. Jessie may die en route to the hospital.
