



Carbon monoxide poisoning is the problem. Cooking in the vestibule was a poor choice especially with the snow and freezing rain accumulating on the outside of the tent fly significantly reducing ventilation. All future cooking should take place outside. Both people need to put on their storm gear and spend time outside, ideally until their headaches subside. All ice and snow should be removed from the tent and fly to increase ventilation and cleared on a regular basis through the remainder of the storm.
