



Red Flags:

- Abdominal pain with a dark tar-like stool and increased pulse.

Evacuation Level:

- Begin a Level 2 Evacuation. Upgrade if S/Sx worsen.

Field Treatment:

- Stop ibuprofen; no NSAIDs.
- Administer OTC proton pump inhibitor (PPI).
- Maintain a bland diet (no fats, acids, or spicy foods) during evacuation.
- Monitor for S/Sx of internal bleeding.

Explanation:

His S/Sx indicate a bleeding peptic ulcer.
