***Contracted Tuition** — the per-person cost for a given course type. WMTC contracted tuition is standardized and includes instruction, course materials (e.g. Handbook & SOAP notes for each student), and first aid supplies required for the course. Tuition and contract minimum (how many people the sponsor will be responsible to pay for regardless of how many people attend the course) is included in your contract with the WMTC Licensed Provider.

***Retail Tuition** — the per-person price that sponsors charge the *public* for their course must fall within the retail price range. You may charge one price for public members and a different discounted rate for local partners or groups. Sponsors work with the WMTC office and the Licensed Provider to identify associated costs so that they can budget for and price their courses accordingly.

EXCEPTIONS

In the cases below, you may exceed the top end of the public/retail tuition range. Contact the WMTC office with any questions.

- If you add CPR or AED certification to a course, you may pass that additional cost on to the students.
- Any additional amenities provided as a part of the course (e.g. food or camping) can be added to the retail tuition.
