

# Logistical Information for WWU Wilderness Medicine Courses

## Classroom

All lectures, case study reviews, and some skill labs will be held in the [Viking Union](#). Your instructor, [Jonathan Cooper](#) will send a group email with the classroom number and any updates roughly a week before the start of the course.



## Parking

Parking on campus requires a [permit](#).

- Under permits section select "Get Permits"
- On Customer Authentication page select "Visitor/Department Login" and create guest account.
- Once account is setup, begin process by selecting "Next" on Purchase a Permit page.
- Visitor permits may be for 1-7 days ranging from \$10-\$31.
- For lot choose "C-Guest" *It is a 10-min walk to the Viking Union through campus from this lot.*

Free public parking is available on N. Garden Street and several of the surrounding streets; be aware of the posted regulations on each block as they differ.
